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Defense - Fouls	Excessive fouling: stop the game and coach player(s) on "why it's a foul" Continue the game. If same/similar type of fouling continues then offending player(s) must be removed for the remainder of the PERIOD OR QUARTER/HALF.	2 Fouls within the same period - player must be substituted out immediately and sit out remainder of period/quarter. If 2nd foul occurs within 1 minute of the end of the period/quarter then player is removed immediately and also sits the following period/quarter	3 Fouls within the same QUARTER (2 periods) - player must be substituted out immediately and sit out remainder of QUARTER (2 periods). If 3rd foul occurs within 1 minute of the end of the quarter then player is removed immediately and also sits the following quarter. Players can sit two periods in a row due to fouls	2 Fouls within the same period - player must be substituted out immediately and sit out remainder of period/quarter.
